PROGRAM BACKGROUND

Jubilee Homes' Build to Work Program (B2W) was created to address and eliminate barriers to employment for job seekers. We understand that without the necessary education and training credentials needed for a career, including academic degrees, most job seekers would not be considered for jobs that are in high demand. Instead, they risk following a downward spiral and dropping out of the job market entirely.

Our participants have:

- Completed a 2-week Soft skills, Life Skills and Work Readiness Program
- A current Resume
- 2 Forms of ID
- A Transportation Plan and/or Childcare Plan
- Good Attendance & Time Management

Jubilee Homes' Build to Work Staff recruits new Employer Partners on an ongoing basis.

Our staff visits businesses monthly to:

1. Inform you of our workforce development services,
2. Assess your current employment needs and open positions.
3. Invite you to participate in our upcoming Employer Events such as Job Fairs & Hiring Events, Annual Parties & Networking Events and our Employer Appreciation Luncheons.

Our goal is to establish on the ground, lasting relationships with employers that lead to employment opportunities for our participants and to help with company needs.

Our Education & Occupational Training Partners provides access to skill certifications and trainings that employers are looking for in:

- Retail/Customer Service/Hospitality
- Foodservice
- Manufacturing
- Construction: OSHA 10 & Flagger
- Healthcare / Medical Technology

These certifications and skills, once acquired, will increase each participant's opportunity for employment and/or career advancement and/or job placement.

PROGRAM SERVICES

Needs Base Assistance:

Upon completion of our 2 Week training participants may be eligible to receive assistance with work related needs that include: Drivers License or NYS Non-Drivers ID, transportation assistance, uniforms, background checks, birth certificate, ect... Many of our services are available to your current employees, call us if an employee needs assistance.

Legal Assistance:

- Certificate of Good Conduct
- Removal of inaccuracies on background checks
- Assistance with traffic tickets
- License suspension (service may vary depending on the infraction)

Educational and Occupational Training Assistance:

- Program Partners— Onondaga Community College and SUNY EOC offer trainings at little or no cost to aid in career advancement or job placement.
- Access to High School Equivalency Diploma
- Onpoint for College provides assistance to individuals looking to obtain their college degree.
